4 YEAR JOURNEYMAN WIREMAN APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Apply anytime during the year before June 1 in order to be considered for the next school year that begins every August. Applications are available online <https://www.brejatc.org/applyonline> or in person at the training center – 13456 Jefferson Highway, Baton Rouge, LA 70817. Visit our website www.brejatc.org to find out what documents we require for submission with your application. Please note that we strongly encourage all applicants to utilize our online application system.
2. Applicants who have completed an application and submitted all documentation will be notified by email, text and mail of their assigned date and time to report to our training center for aptitude testing. The aptitude test evaluates your proficiency levels in math and reading to determine your readiness for classes. It is not used to disqualify applicants; however, it is required for admission into the program. Applicants can find resources on our website www.brejatc.org to help brush up on math and reading skills. Aptitude tests will be given periodically throughout the year.
3. After an applicant has taken the aptitude test, an interview will be scheduled when the Joint Apprenticeship & Training Committee is ready to do so. Applicants will be notified by mail and email of an upcoming interview. Applicants will be interviewed in the order in which they applied.
4. Acceptance notification letters will be mailed within two weeks after the interview with further information. If accepted, the packet will include important forms and information, so it is VITAL that your mailing address on file is ACCURATE and up-to-date.
